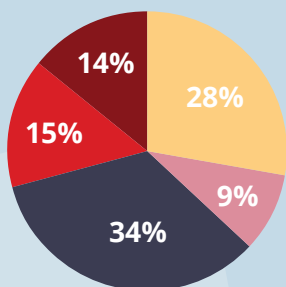

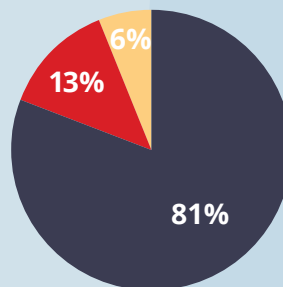

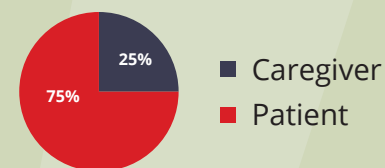

The study abstract, "Impact of Psychosocial Distress Screening Partnership with Cancer Support Community SF Bay Area in an Ambulatory Community-Based Cancer Center: A Retrospective Cohort Study," was accepted for publication and presented at the Academy of Oncology Nurse and Patient Navigators Annual Conference in Las Vegas. CSC Welcomed Social Work Interns

In 2024 a new social work practicum student program was added to the Clinical Department to support CSC participants with additional resource navigation and other support services. This year there were 2 Masters level students added to the staff who supported participants with in-home counseling services, patient navigation, intake sessions, group facilitations and other counseling sessions, as well as conducting research projects on patient care practices.
